

## **DISCIPLESHIP RESOURCES**

### **Individual or Group Studies**

**Essential Christianity** (6 lessons) – Bill Hybels –Excellent study of the basics including how to know and follow Christ, grow in confidence, handle failures and receive guidance. Leaders' notes included.

**MasterLife Book 1, The Disciples' Cross**(6 lessons) – Avery Willis – Deepen your walk with Christ as you practice the 6 disciplines of a disciple; each week has 5 days of homework including scripture memory.

**MasterLife Book 2, The Disciples' Personality** (6 lessons) – Avery Willis – Develop Christlikeness in character as you learn to live in the Spirit; homework, scripture memory.

**The Call to Follow Christ** (7 lessons) – Claude King – a “lite” version of MasterLife Book 1 but very good

**Abide in Christ** (6 lessons) – Andrew Murray & Bo Stevens – a “lite” version of MasterLife Book 2.

**Experiencing God** (13 lessons) – Henry Blackaby & Claude King – Helps believers know and do God's will and wait upon God's timing; is a workbook; DVDs available as well.

**Twelve Ordinary Men; Twelve Extraordinary Women** (12 lessons) – John MacArthur – Book & workbook; explores the lives of the 12 disciples and 12 women of the Bible. Theme: God uses ordinary men & women to fulfill His extraordinary purposes.

**Disciple's PrayerLife** (13 lessons) – T.W. Hunt and Catherine Walker – Learn how to pray based on the prayers of the Bible; is a workbook with daily study.

**The Mind of Christ** (12 lessons) – T.W. Hunt & Claude King – a challenging study examining Christ's mind and character; is a workbook.

**The Bible in 90 Days** (13 weeks) – NIV Zondervan Publishers – Read through the entire Bible in 90 days as part of a unique group experience; participants guide and DVD lessons.

**Kay Arthur Studies** – any of the Kay Arthur studies are excellent; topical or books of the Bible – Precept Ministries International.

#### **Classics**

**Confessions** – Augustine, Bishop of Hippo, early church father (A.D. 354-430).

**Pilgrim's Progress** – John Bunyan – 17<sup>th</sup> Century allegory of the life of the Christian.

**Religious Affections** – Jonathan Edwards, brilliant theologian of the 18<sup>th</sup> century and first President of Princeton University.

**Mere Christianity** – C.S. Lewis, brilliant Christian thinker of 20<sup>th</sup> Century, author of Chronicles of Narnia; this book is an absolute must for anyone seeking the Lord.

**Screwtape Letters** – C.S. Lewis; letters between demons who seek to tempt Christians.

**Weight of Glory** – C.S. Lewis; a collection of topical studies based on his lectures.

**Lectures to My Students** - Charles Spurgeon, great English Baptist preacher of 19<sup>th</sup> Century.

**Morning and Evening** – Charles Spurgeon; daily devotional readings.

**Cost of Discipleship** – Deitrich Bonhoeffer, godly Lutheran Pastor who was executed by the Nazis in Germany in 1945; study guide for groups called **Costly Grace** by Dale & Sandy Larson (6 lessons).  
**The Pursuit of God** – A.W. Tozer – In each of the 10 chapters, he explains an aspect of waiting on God  
**Spiritual Maturity** – J. Oswald Sanders  
**Spiritual Leadership** – J. Oswald Sanders  
**Knowing God** – J.I. Packer  
**My Utmost for His Highest** - Oswald Chambers; daily devotional  
**The Imitation of Christ** – Thomas a Kempis, Augustinian monk; his dates: 1380-1471.  
**Kingdom of the Cults** – Walter Martin; explores in detail the major cults (Mormonism, Jehovah’s Witnesses, Christian Science, etc.)
