



LESSON 3: Comparing Worldviews

ANCHOR STATEMENT: A person's view of the world is vastly different depending on how they view God, what they believe about righteousness, and their understanding of humanity's purpose.

MAIN PASSAGE: Isaiah 40:29-31

*He gives strength to the faint
and strengthens the powerless.*

30 Youths may become faint and weary,

and young men stumble and fall,

31 but those who trust in the Lord

will renew their strength;

they will soar on wings like eagles;

they will run and not become weary,

they will walk and not faint.

WHAT WE WANT STUDENTS TO KNOW: Students should learn the differences between a biblical worldview and the worldviews held by the other major world religions.

WHAT WE WANT STUDENTS TO DO WITH WHAT THEY'VE LEARNED:

When encountering people with different religious worldviews, students will have a better understanding what those differences are and how to share a biblical worldview more confidently with others.
