# MUSICAL THEATRE CAMP

SPA Musical Theatre is designed to build students' confidence in stage performance and technique, and to point students to God's truth in classic stories. This year, Musical Theatre Camp students will build their skills in acting, vocal performance, and choreography, as they work together to present a 60-minute production of Disney's "Frozen JR."

Junior Cast members (2nd-4th grade) will learn introductory performance techniques and theatrical terms. The Junior Cast will be part of our Ensemble.

Senior Cast members (5th-9th grade) will build on existing skills as they perform in Featured Ensemble roles and as leading performers.

All students who are placed in the camp will be part of the cast, but cast placement auditions are required for 5th-9th Grade students. Audition details will be sent after registration & placement is final.



Worship Pastors & members of the Worship Ministry team will mentor each group, discipling students in the meaning of worship, while offering technical training and instruction at the student's current level. Camp culminates in a student-led showcase and worship service.

This year, Worship Band Camp will be structured in two levels, with a morning camp for Level I students, and an afternoon camp for Level II. Level I & II will perform together at the end of the week in a student-led worship experience.

### **LEVEL I - Developing Musicians**

*For students with limited experience in an ensemble setting*

- Generally grades 6-9

#### **FOCUS:**

- Spiritual formation - “What is worship? Why do we worship?” - and attaching scripture to song
- Musical Knowledge - Playing in a group; Reading a chord chart; Song structures

LEVEL I students will work on 2-3 songs during the week of camp, and students may be asked to transfer instruments, based on needs determined by our Camp Director.

#### **Pre-Requisites – LEVEL I**

Level I students must have actively taken lessons for a minimum of two years

### **PLACEMENT AUDITIONS**

ALL Worship Band Camp students will be required to submit an audition video. Audition information will be provided once registration is complete.

### **LEVEL II - Emerging Worship Leaders**

*For students with experience playing in a band and experience leading worship in a service*

- Generally grades 9-12

#### **FOCUS:**

- Spiritual formation: Assuming the “what” and “why” of worship are known, how do we apply them to a service liturgy; dissecting theology of popular worship songs; why we sing
- “How to Listen” - musically and spiritually
- Musical Training: In-Depth coaching on their primary instrument or vocal performance technique

Building on the foundation of skills learned in previous years of Worship Band Camp and/or practical experience, LEVEL II students will receive advanced coaching on their primary instrument, or vocal performance, with a special emphasis on preparing a service experience at the end of the camp week. Students will also focus on structuring a service flow, and why we worship.

#### **PRE-REQUISITES – Level II**

- Students must have been part of a worship team (LIVE, etc.)
- Attended SPA Worship Band Camp for two years (preferred)

The summer private lesson semester offers students interested in studying a particular musical instrument or vocal technique the opportunity to study one-on-one with an instructor. Summer lessons are a great opportunity for current students to continue in their study or for students to try a new instrument or discipline for a limited time commitment.

Scheduling is based on teacher and student availability—and returning students are given scheduling priority. The summer semester is flexible, but most teachers offer weekly lessons; make-up lessons will be offered for trips or summer activities planned with advance notice to teachers. The summer semester offers eight 30-minute private lessons.

Lessons are held at the Second Baptist Church, Woodway Campus.

# POLICIES

OUR VISION is to equip students of all ages to glorify the Lord with their talents by providing professional quality instruction in a safe, Christ-centered environment.

OUR GOAL is to help students maximize the potential and personal enjoyment of their God-given gifts while training them to be future leaders in performance and ministry.

## **Missed Lesson Policy (Private Lessons)**

If a student is unable to attend a lesson, he or she must inform the School of Performing Arts office and/or the teacher at least 24 hours in advance to qualify as an excused absence. Teachers will be required to extend the same courtesy if they have to cancel a lesson.

**Only two make-up lessons will be given for each semester, and those will be arranged according to the teacher's schedule.** Both make-up lessons must be completed before the beginning of the next semester. There will **NOT** be any rolled over lessons or refunds for student absences whether excused or unexcused.

If a teacher is not informed that a student will miss his/her lesson, it will be counted as an **unexcused absence** and will NOT be made up.

Students will be required to make payment for lessons that:

1. They attend.
2. Are unexcused absences.
3. Are make-up lessons from an excused absence.

## **Missed Lesson Policy (Summer Camps and Weekly Classes)**

Due to the nature of the group environment, there will be no make-ups offered for missed time at our summer camps or classes, unless specified in our class schedule. We will offer an optional make-up time for students missing certain classes for summer camps through Second Baptist Church.

## **Refund Policy**

The \$10 summer registration fee, which is not included in the price of all lessons and camps, is non-refundable.

Tuition for private lessons, dance classes, intensives or summer camps is non-refundable once the lessons, classes or camp has begun. Should a student need to terminate lessons or camp early, a refund of payments made cannot be given.

## **Materials/Curriculum**

Students will be expected to provide their own instrument, accessories, and literature for private lessons, as required by their teacher. Pianos are available for students to play during their lesson time, but not for individual practice during the week. Teachers will inform students of any particular method books, musical pieces, etc., they will need, and it is the responsibility of the student to purchase these materials in a timely manner.

Musical Theatre & Dance Camp students will be asked to supplement pieces for costumes, but there will be no extra charge for costuming at summer camp. Worship Band Camp students should plan to provide a personal instrument, unless playing drums or keyboard. SPA DANCE students will be required to purchase proper dancewear and shoes for the course. ART class supplies will be provided by SPA.

## **Recitals/Performances**

There is no recital for private lessons or the Summer Dance Intensives during the summer semester. All summer camps include a required performance for friends and family at the end of camp.
