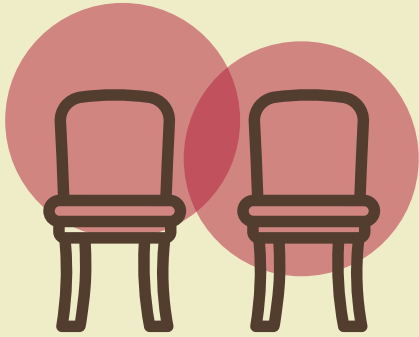


# Best Practices for Adult Bible Study Classes

In accordance with CDC guidelines and the Governor's Office recommendations and in addition to the worship guidelines concerning masks, high-risk groups, touchless greeting, etc., these best practices are utilized by Second Baptist Church in Adult Bible Study on each campus.



## 1. Set Up:

Classrooms will be pre-set in accordance with social distancing protocols. Classes will be instructed not to rearrange chairs or tables.



## 3. Food:

Attendees will be encouraged to bring their own personal refreshments if needed. Only pre-packaged, individually wrapped food or beverages are allowed in rooms. No coffee carts or other shared containers are permitted.

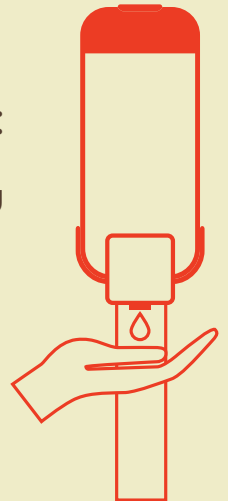


## 5. Zoom/Teachers:

- Accommodations should be made to include class members attending from home and any Teachers needing to teach from home. ABS staff can assist with technical needs.
- No handouts should be used at this time.

## 2. Room Sanitization:

In addition to the deep cleaning by Second Baptist Church cleaning services, supplies will be provided in each room for the class to use before their class begins and after it ends. **This way each room should be sanitized twice before use.** Instructions will be provided on methods and best practices.



## 4. Attendance:

- Classes will be encouraged to take attendance through the SBC Playbook App instead of their paper roster. If needed, one person should be designated to mark attendance on the roster.
- Visitor cards should be completed by the visitor and submitted in the blue envelope. Visitor contact information will be automatically sent to Directors and Teachers via the Playbook App.
