

Classroom Best Practices for Children's Ministry

In accordance with CDC guidelines and the Governor's Office recommendations concerning best practices for the Children's Ministry, these guidelines are utilized by Second Baptist Church.

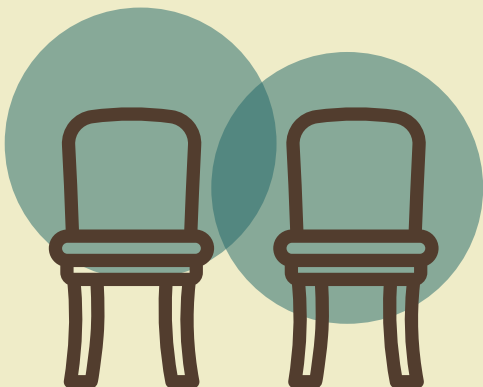
1. Temperature:

Anyone entering the childcare areas will have their temperature taken upon arrival. This includes childcare workers, children, and guardians.



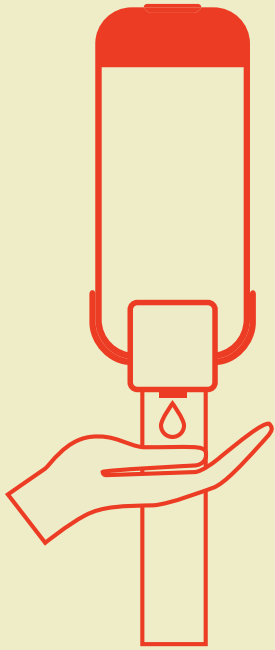
2. Check-In:

Each child needs to be checked in at the Kiosk for their ministry area. Only **one** parent guardian is allowed in the children's area to drop off and pickup each week.



3. Set Up:

Classrooms will be pre-set as appropriate for age in accordance with the social distancing protocols.



4. **Sanitization:**

Anyone entering the childcare areas will be requested to use appropriate hand sanitization measures upon arrival. This includes childcare workers, children, and guardians. All program space will be sanitized before and after use. Common area touch surfaces will be frequently sanitized.



5. **Food:**

Food cannot be brought into any childcare area. Bottles provided by guardians will be allowed. Pre-packaged, individually wrapped snacks will be provided by Second Baptist Church as needed for toddlers.

6. **Class Materials:**

Individually used items like paper, glue sticks, and markers will be provided for each student in each class session. Items will be sanitized before the next use.
