1. **Temperature:**

Anyone entering the Student Ministry area will have their temperature taken upon arrival. This includes students, adult leaders, and staff.

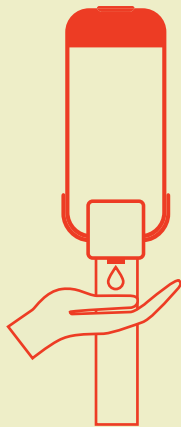
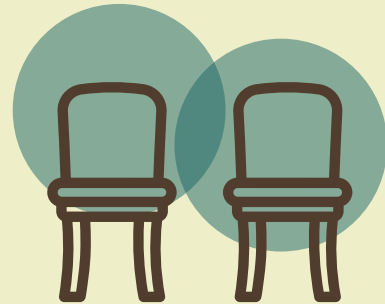


2. **Check-In:**

Each student and adult will check in at the "Welcome Table" when they enter the Student Ministry area. The Welcome Table Greeter will check them in as they arrive. Students and adults will not have to fill anything out. Guests will give the Greeter basic information to be followed up with by the Youth Staff.

3. **Set Up:**

The Student Ministry room will provide appropriate social distancing measures.



4. **Sanitization:**

Anyone entering the Student Ministry area will be requested to use appropriate hand sanitation measures upon arrival. All program space will be cleaned and sanitized before and after use.

5. **Food:**

Food and drinks cannot be brought into the Student Ministry area.
