MUSICAL THEATRE CAMP 2024

Musical Theatre Camp is designed to build confidence in students' ability to perform on stage. Students will work on singing, dancing, and acting, and will learn audition and performance techniques in musical theatre. They will then perform *Bye Bye Birdie (Youth Edition)* on stage for a large audience at the end of the week. All students who are placed in the camp will be part of the cast, but **placement auditions are required** for **5th-9th Grade students**. Details will be sent after registration is final.

REGISTRATION NOTE:

All students will be placed in a "VIRTUAL QUEUE" at registration. Students will be added to camp enrollment in the order that online registration is complete and as space is available in the requested group. **SPACE IS LIMITED.**

"Bye Bye Birdie" will be presented at 3:00 pm on Friday, June 7, in the C Gym Theatre. Join SPA DANCE for "Everybody Dance!" Level I or II and prep your dance steps for Camp!

Worship Band Camp is a time for students to learn what it means to worship God together through music. Led by Second Baptist Worship Pastors, students are taught to apply their musical knowledge while playing as an ensemble and learning diverse styles and techniques, focusing on songs and hymns in a contemporary Christian format.

Camp culminates in a student-led worship concert on Thursday, June 27 @ 3:30 pm.

Interested students should have **at least two years of experience** in a primary instrument or vocals, and will be asked to submit a placement video prior to camp. Submission details will be provided after registration.

DANCE CAMP 2024





SPA Dance Camps are designed to foster a love of different styles of dance by exposing students to a new genre each day.

Our morning camp for older dancers will focus on ballet technique, lyrical, and jazz, while our younger dancers will spend the afternoon studying a combination of ballet, jazz, musical theatre, and hip hop. Camp ends with a finale performance on Thursday, featuring all dancers.

The summer private lesson semester offers eight 30-minute private lessons with student and teacher.

Scheduling is based on teacher and student availability—and returning students are given scheduling priority. The summer semester is flexible, but most teachers offer weekly lessons; make-up lessons will be offered for trips or summer activities planned with advance notice to teachers.

Current SPA dancers should register for their 2023-2024 class level. Dancers in grades 6-8 looking to be placed in a level should register for "Intermediate Ballet Technique" on Mondays.

EVERYBODY DANCE!

A Broadway dance class for dancers and students registered for Musical Theatre **Camp**. These classes will focus on technique preparation for the show, as well as special choreography for Bye Bye Birdie. One class period in Everybody Dance II will be used for choreography placement auditions.

SPA Summer Dance Intensives offer dancers the opportunity to deepen & strengthen dance technique in a relaxed, yet challenging, environment. These are highly recommended for dancers looking to grow in the art of dance.

NEW SCHEDULE FOR SUMMER 2024!

This year, our Summer Intensives will be spread across a two- or three-day week of classes, based on level, and will offer dancers the opportunity to study multiple styles and genres of dance. Summer Intensives are designed for dancers with formal experience in dance.

LEVEL A (Rising 4th-6th Grade) 3 years experience preferred or current SPA dancer LEVEL B (Rising 6th-8th Grade) 3 years experience preferred or current SPA dancer LEVEL C (Rising 8th-12th Grade) 4 years experience preferred or current SPA dancer

This year's summer intensives will includes classes in: Ballet Technique, Ballet Conditioning, Ballet Variations, Pre-Pointe, Pointe, Modern, Jazz, Broadway/Musical Theatre, Composition, and Hip Hop.

Register for one week, two weeks, or all three!

3:00-3:45 pm Intro to Ballet 3:45-4:30 pm Summer on Broadway

Intro to Ballet is designed for dancers in Grade 6 and up looking for a refresher in their dance technique. This class will focus on fundamentals of ballet technique including body alignment and placement of the body. Traditional barre, center work, and ballet combinations will be included through praise and worship and Contemporary Christian music. This class is highly recommended for middle school dancers planning to join our 2024-2025 season.

Summer on Broadway will focus on the fundamentals of Broadway-style Jazz and Tap and is a great option for students interested in musical theatre. This class is open to both boys and girls.

SBC SCHOOL OF PERFORMING ARTS SUMMER 2024 POLICIES

Missed Lesson Policy (Private Lessons)

If a student is unable to attend a lesson, he or she must inform the School of Performing Arts office and/or the teacher <u>at least **24** hours in advance</u> to qualify as an excused absence. Teachers will be required to extend the same courtesy if they have to cancel a lesson.

Only two make-up lessons will be given for each semester, and those will be arranged according to the teacher's schedule. Both make-up lessons must be completed before the beginning of the next semester. There will <u>NOT</u> be any rolled over lessons or refunds for student absences whether excused or unexcused.

If a teacher is not informed that a student will miss his/her lesson, it will be counted as an <u>unexcused ab-</u><u>sence</u> and will <u>NOT</u> be made up.

Students will be required to make payment for lessons that:

- 1. They attend.
- 2. Are unexcused absences.
- 3. Are make-up lessons from an excused absence.

Missed Lesson Policy (Summer Camps and Summer Dance)

Due to the nature of the group environment, there will be no make-ups offered for missed time at our summer camps or classes, unless specified in our class schedule. We will offer an optional make-up time for students missing certain classes for summer camps through Second Baptist Church.

Refund Policy

The \$10 summer registration fee, which is not included in the price of all lessons and camps, is non-refundable.

Tuition for private lessons, dance classes, intensives or summer camps is non-refundable once the lessons, classes or camp has begun. Should a student need to terminate lessons or camp early, a refund of payments made <u>cannot</u> be given.

Materials/Curriculum

Students will be expected to provide their own instrument, accessories, and literature for private lessons, as required by their teacher. Pianos are available for students to play during their lesson time, but not for individual practice during the week. Teachers will inform students of any particular method books, musical pieces, etc., they will need, and it is the responsibility of the student to purchase these materials in a timely manner.

Musical Theatre & Dance Camp students will be asked to supplement pieces for costumes, but there will be no extra charge for costuming at summer camp. Worship Band Camp students should plan to provide a personal instrument, unless playing drums or keyboard.

SPA DANCE students will be required to purchase proper dancewear and shoes for the course.

Recitals/Performances

There is no recital for private lessons or the Summer Dance Intensives during the summer semester. All summer camps include a required performance for friends and family at the end of camp.
