The wound care doctor did say they'll try to improve the vasculature in the leg, but that he needs to mentally prepare himself for possible amputation to above the knee. He did receive 3 units of blood, and iron, as well as a bunch of IV antibiotics, so he's feeling a lot better right now, although he still has gangrene of the toes of course.
